

Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Notification 2019-2020

The Watertown-Mayer School District has a goal of providing a safe, comfortable and productive environment for our students and employees so that we achieve our core mission—educating students. To help achieve this goal, the school board has adopted an IAQ Management Plan. This plan will help the school district improve IAQ by preventing as many IAQ problems as possible, and by quickly responding to any IAQ problems that may arise.

You may review the IAQ Management Plan free of charge by visiting the district office, which is located in the middle school at 1001 Highway 25 NW in Watertown, Minnesota. Copies of the plan may also be purchased at 10 cents (\$.10) per page.

You may also report any IAQ concern by completing an IAQ Concern Reporting Form. Copies of these forms are located in each school office.

The district office also contains additional information about where to find self-help information to evaluate IAQ in the home, how to obtain information about the structural features and operational practices of the school buildings, and how to obtain information on what parents can do to address IAQ issues that cannot be resolved through the concern reporting process.
