

The USDA has extended the Summer Food Service Program to all students enrolled in Kindergarten and up at Watertown-Mayer, which gives families the option to participate in our meal program for both breakfast and lunch, **free of charge**.

We will continue to offer wonderful meal options to our students in an effort to assist in their learning experience at Watertown-Mayer.

Meal details

Free meals are available only to students enrolled at Watertown-Mayer Public Schools. One of each meal per day per student, second meals will be charged full adult price

The intent is to provide one breakfast and one lunch per student, per day.

Students will still be charged for ala carte items, second entrees and additional cartons of milk. (Please keep money in your students' account for them to do so and to be prepared for when the Summer Food Service Program ends.)

Any students who are distance learning, or any WM hybrid students who are not on campus, can sign up to receive meals. Anyone wishing to participate please go to our website and sign up by the Friday prior to the week of needing meals. Please note if you want breakfast only, lunch only, or both.

Pick-up is at W-M High School Door #6 on student days from 11:30 AM to 1:00 PM.
